Here are a few tips to help plan your trip...

What's available at camp...

- Fishing and hunting licenses
- Lake maps (general overview map and detailed laminated depth charts.)
- Padded, swivel boat seats
- Fresh drinking water (drawn from well - regularly tested)
- Fresh, clean bed linens , wool blankets and pillows.
- Live bait (night crawlers)
- Life jackets (Coast Guard approved vest style)
- Fish landing nets
- Gas and outboard oil
- Assorted fishing lures
- Souvenirs - ball caps, t-shirts, sweatshirts
- Shore lunch kits

What's available in the village of Biscotasing...

- Pay phone
- Ice
- Live bait (minnows)
- Snack foods
- Beer and liquor
- Dry goods & groceries (limited and expensive)

What to bring along...

- Fishing gear
- Insect repellent
- Sunscreen, hat, sunglasses
- Fresh fruit and vegetables
- Rain gear
- Personal towels for showering/washing

When you arrive...

- Telephone us from the Biscotasing General Store at 239-2846. (ask the owner of the Store to call us OR use the payphone outside the store, note: the payphone does not accept coins only credit cards.)
- Parking is at our mainland property. There is no charge for this. Once you have called from the General Store, follow the "Live Bait" signs until you see a sign for "Ritchie's"
- Begin loading your gear on the main dock. It will take approximately 10 minutes for the pontoon boat to arrive.
- NOTE: arrival time is any time after 10 am. If you arrive before this time you maybe asked to enjoy the scenery until we are ready for pick-up

Changes or cancellations

It is very important for us to know of any changes in your plans – even if these changes occur at the last minute.

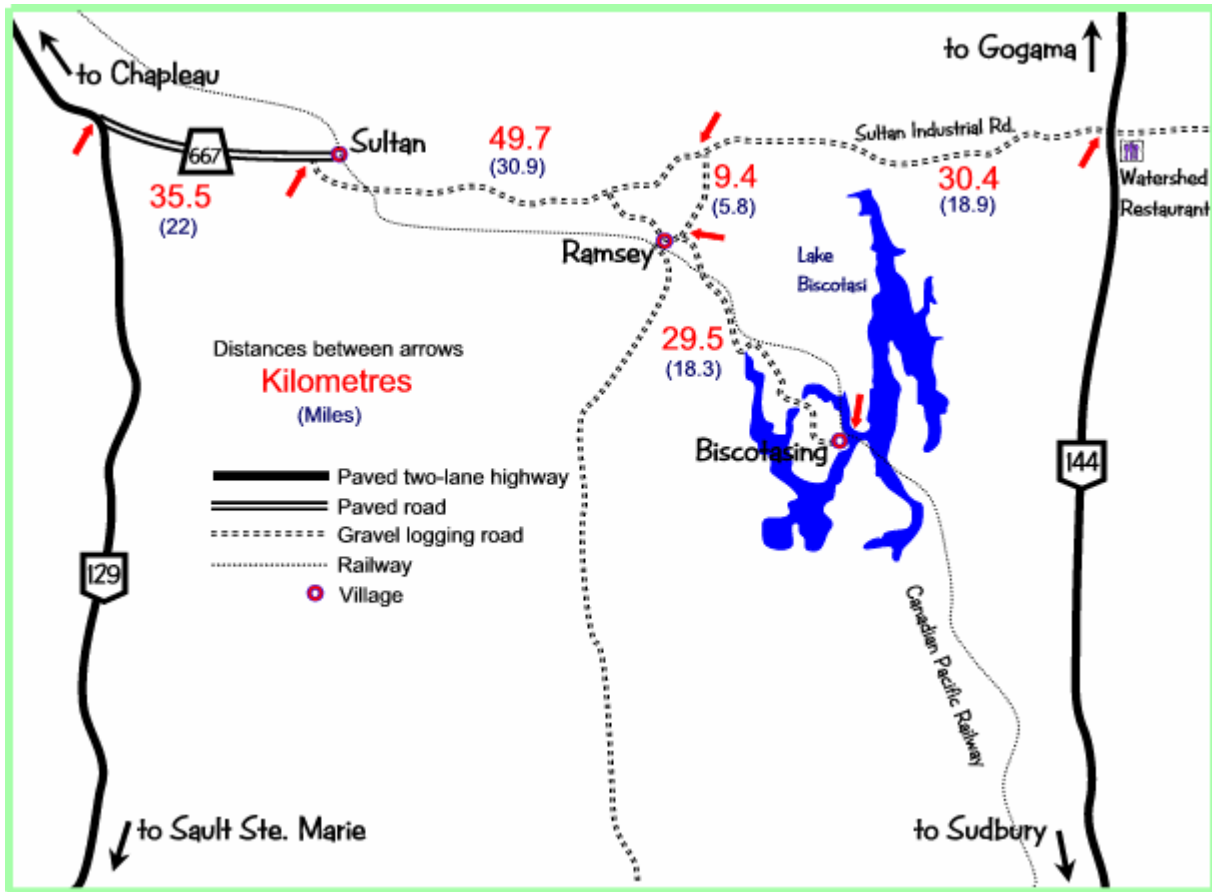
In particular we need to know any changes in party size, arrival time, cancellations or any other pertinent information you might feel we should know. This will aid us in preparing for your stay with us!

If arriving via SUDBURY...

- Start in the town of Chelmsford which is north of Sudbury following Elm St. north or by taking the Sudbury by-pass.
- Take Hwy 144 north of Chelmsford for approximately 1½ hours (134 kms/83 miles).
- Turn left on to Sultan Industrial Road* at the Watershed Restaurant.
- Go west on logging road for 30.4 kms/18.9 miles.
- Turn left and continue for 9.4 kms/5.8 miles.
- Turn left and continue for 29.5 kms/18.3 miles to the village of Biscotasing.

If arriving via S.S. Marie...

- Take HWY 17 east to the town of Thessalon approximately 86 kms/53 miles.
- Turn left on Hwy 129 and travel north for 188 kms/117 miles.
- Turn right on Hwy 667 towards the village of Sultan for 35.5 kms/22 miles then turn right onto the Sultan Industrial Rd*. This gravel road begins 0.5 km before the village of Sultan.
- Take this road for 49.7 kms/30.9 miles.
- Turn right and continue on this road for 9.4 kms/5.8 miles.

- Turn left and continue on this road for 29.5 kms/18.3 miles to the village of Biscotasing

* Sultan Industrial Road is an active logging road. It is well maintained and is passable by car or 4X4. Weather conditions can make the road 'wash board' and may produce potholes. Take your time - you will get there!

If arriving via train from SUDBURY...

- The Canadian Pacific Railway station is located in downtown Sudbury on Elgin St.
- The train departs for Biscotasing at 9:00 am on Saturdays.
- The 'Bud Car', as it is known, is scheduled to arrive in Biscotasing at 12 noon.
- The Bud Car departs for Sudbury the following Friday at approximately 3:15 pm and arrives in Sudbury at around 6:30 pm.
- If you wish, contact Erinn, to book your travel arrangements.

NOTE: It is important to call VIA RAIL ahead of time to confirm departure times, ticket sales, and reservations.
